
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

# What are some historically profitable horse racing investing strategies using recent Statfreaks data?

Highlighted below are two strategies that have shown a consistent positive return on investment from 2022 to the present. 




# **QUESTIONS & ANSWERS**

### Have there been any profitable models that have used the "BR" barrier rating factor in Statfreaks data?

Two effective strategies have emerged from our "Barrier Rating/Rank" since 2022. While the top-ranked barrier (Barrier rank 1) often faces over-betting, diminishing its value, rated barriers ranked 2nd to 5th have historically demonstrated better returns.

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






# **ANALYSIS —STAYING RACE TYPES**

Important pre-race variables and statistics

Let's examine statistics in Australian metropolitan track races, specifically those flat races with distances ranging from 2800m to 3400m. Our focus will be to analyse the strike rates of pivotal factors and determine the common profiles or origins of the winners.

It appears that after 12 runs in a current prep, the likelihood of a win diminishes significantly. Most contenders hit their peak performance around their 4th to 5th race and generally start to show a decline in form thereafter. Additionally, there's a noticeable drop in success for horses starting from barriers beyond the 12th position.

When it comes to staying races, such as the **Melbourne Cup**, our analysis indicates that the "TR" Trainer rating is a critical factor. We advise that for such races, **greater emphasis should be placed on the Statfreaks "TR" ranking** when assessing the potential outcomes.



# RIDERS – BEST SF RIDE OF DAY AND RANK 1 OR 2.



# **JOCKEY/TRAINER REVIEW PROCESS**

At the end of each month, we identify the top jockeys and trainers based on our detailed data analysis. These are individuals who have consistently demonstrated exceptional strike rate performance and contributed to profitable outcomes when ranked high on our statfreaks ratings. When a rider/trainer or combo has dropped out of market performance for more than 3 months rolling, they are removed from the tracking table.






