DO YOU HAVE ANY STATS AND INTEL ON JOCKEYS' RIDES THAT SHORTEN IN THE MARKET?

Presented is a year-to-date analysis for Australian riders, showcasing the average percentage decrease in odds from the Opening Price to the Jump Price, as well as from the 9am Price to the Jump Price.

This data specifically highlights instances where the odds have consistently shortened from their initial offering to the start of the race.

Leading the statistics is Tyler Schiller, whose mounts have seen an average shortening in odds of approximately 79.6%. Close on his heels are Jarrow Fry and Keagan Latham, with average odds shortening of 77.1% and 77.0%, respectively.

William Pike and Aaron Bullock stand out as the only two riders who have consistently achieved a strike rate above 30% with odds that have shortened on their rides.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

WHICH TRACKS HAVE THE LOWEST WIN STRIKE RATE WHEN LEADING?

Australian horse racing tracks with the lowest win rates for leaders, all having win strike rates of 21% or below..

The attention is drawn to tracks with subpar performance, where both win and place strike rates are relatively low.

Murray Bridge GH stands out with the lowest win strike rate at 11.0% combined with a modest place strike rate of 29.0%.

Similarly, Pakenham Synthetic and Wangaratta both share a win strike rate of 12.0%, with place strike rates of 32.0% and 35.0% respectively.

These figures indicate that horses leading at the 800-meter mark at these tracks have a lower probability of maintaining their lead to secure a win or place finish, suggesting that at these venues, an early lead does not significantly enhance the chances of finishing in a top position.

LAY BETTING — BETFAIR

Welcome to lay betting, a unique betting strategy on Betfair. Unlike traditional betting where you bet on an outcome to happen, lay betting allows you to bet against an outcome.

In horse racing, when you lay a horse, you're betting it won't win. If any other horse wins, your bet wins. If the horse you laid wins, your bet loses. Essentially, you're acting as the bookmaker.

The odds in lay betting are reverse of traditional betting. For example, if you lay a horse at odds of 4.0 with a \$10 stake, you'll win \$10 if the horse loses. However, if the horse wins, you'll have to pay out \$30. The liability (the amount you could lose) in lay betting can often be more than the amount you stand to win.

In essence, lay betting allows you to profit not only from picking winners, but also from picking losers. It's a valuable tool that, once mastered, can significantly broaden your betting strategy.

MARKET MOVERS AND DRIFTERS ANALYSIS.

In the context of horse racing, the dynamics of the odds reflect collective investor sentiment and the complex interplay of market conditions.

A 'price drift' denotes a scenario where the odds on a horse lengthen, signalling a dip in investor confidence or a reaction to shifts within the betting landscape, which may suggest a lower probability of the horse's top performance. Conversely, when a horse's price shortens, it means the odds are becoming more favourable, reflecting an aggregation of investments and a bolstered expectation of the horse's chances of success.

Understanding these shifts is fundamental for investors aiming to make informed decisions. It is not merely about recognizing which horse is gaining or losing support but discerning why these movements are happening – be it due to a change in track conditions, public perception, or the late revelation of critical information about the horse's condition or the jockey's strategy.

Horses ranked top weight that experienced a price drift: 55,006 instances, which is approximately 52.81% of the total observed cases.

Horses that shortened in price: 46,218 instances, corresponding to about 44.38%. Horses that held their price: 2,925 instances, representing roughly 2.81%.

These figures continue to suggest that top weight horses are more likely to either drift or shorten in price, with a slight prevalence for drifting. Holding the price remains the least common among the price movements observed.

In the context of horses that are 'first up' (racing for the first time in a season or after a break):

Horses that experienced a price drift: 36,836 instances, which is approximately 56.24% of the total recorded. Horses that shortened in price: 27,136 instances, about 41.43%.

Horses that held their price: 1,530 instances, making up roughly 2.34%.

This data indicates that 'first up' horses are more likely to have their odds drift than shorten, with a significant majority showing a price drift. The occurrence of price holding is relatively minimal.

When analysing races where the jockey is rated the best in the race according to the Statfreaks jockey rating:

Horses that shortened in price: 22,114 instances, making up about 59.22% of the cases.

Horses that experienced a price drift: 14,085 instances, approximately 37.72%.

Horses that held their price: 1,146 instances, which is around 3.07%.

This analysis reveals that horses ridden by statfreaks top-rated jockeys tend to have their prices shorten more often than drift, indicating a strong investor confidence associated with these jockeys. The least frequent occurrence is the price holding steady.

 For horses that have the best rated statfreaks trainer rating in a race:

There were 24,652 instances of price shortening, accounting for approximately 50.95% of the total cases. Price drifting occurred 22,264 times, representing around 46.01%.

The price held steady in 1,471 instances, which is about 3.04%.

These figures indicate that horses with the statfreaks top-rated trainers have a slightly higher tendency for their prices to shorten rather than drift, with both movements occurring fairly close in frequency. The holding of price is considerably less common compared to the other two movements.

For horses that won their last start:

Price drift was noted in 26,352 instances, making up approximately 53.98% of the cases.

Price shortening occurred 21,043 times, accounting for about 43.11%.

The price held steady in 1,422 instances, roughly 2.91%.

This analysis suggests that horses with a win in their last start are more likely to experience a drift in price compared to shortening. The frequency of the price holding steady is the least common outcome. This could indicate that despite recent wins, there is still a level of uncertainty among investors that leads to fluctuating odds.

For horses that are carrying more weight compared to their last start:

Price drift occurred in 98,630 instances, which is about 51.11% of the total number observed.

Price shortening was noted in 89,164 instances, approximately 46.21%.

The price held steady in 5,166 instances, making up roughly 2.68%.

This data shows that horses going up in weight have a slightly higher tendency to experience a drift in price rather than a shortening. The incidence of prices holding steady is relatively low in comparison to the other two price movements. This could suggest that an increase in weight is a factor that investors consider significant enough to affect a horse's chances, leading to more variable odds.

For horses running on a 7-day backup:

Horses with a price shortening: 8,273 instances, which accounts for approximately 52.71% of the total observed.

Horses experiencing a price drift: 6,961 instances, about 44.35%. Horses whose price held steady: 460 instances, roughly 2.93%.

This data indicates that horses on a 7-day backup are more likely to have their prices shorten rather than drift or hold, pointing to a pattern where quick returns to racing may influence investor confidence positively. Price holding is notably infrequent in this scenario.

For horses on a 14-day backup:

Price drift occurred in 27,941 instances, representing 51.36% of the total.

Price shortening was noted in 25,035 instances, about 46.02%.

Price holding steady was observed in 1,423 instances, which is 2.62%.

Comparing this to the 7-day backup data:

The 14-day backup sees a slightly lower percentage of price drifts (51.36% vs. 52.71%) and a higher percentage of price shortens (46.02% vs. 44.35%).

The occurrence of price holding is marginally less frequent in the 14-day backup (2.62% vs. 2.93%).

This comparison suggests that the length of the backup period can affect price movements, with the 14-day backup showing a closer balance between drifting and shortening, whereas the 7-day backup shows a higher tendency for shortening. Price holding remains the least common in both periods.
